In particular, they are going to focus on the various lessons to be learned from some of the recent key cases, including *Surrey and Sussex Healthcare NHS Trust v Logan Construction (South East) Ltd* [2017] EWHC 17 (TCC) (validity of Payless Notices), *Kersfield Developments v Bray and Slaughter* [2017] EWHC 15 (TCC) (validity of Payless Notices), *Caledonian Modular Ltd v Mar City Developments Ltd* [2015] EWHC 1855 (TCC) (validity of Application for Payment), *Harding v Paice* [2015] EWCA Civ 1231 (failure to serve valid Payless Notices), *Grove Developments v Balfour Beatty* [2016] EWCA Civ 990 (agreed payment schedules) and *Severfield (UK) Ltd v Duro Felguera UK Ltd* [2015] EWHC 3352 (TCC) (hybrid contracts).

Richard (led by Fiona Sinclair QC) acted for the successful respondent in the Supreme Court in *Aspect Contracts v Higgins Construction plc* [2015] UKSC 38, the landmark case in which the Court addressed for the first time the interactions between construction adjudication, limitation, negative declarations and unjust
