Domestic and International Adjudication: The Future of Construction Dispute Resolution and Beyond

This event examines statutory and contractual adjudication from both domestic and international perspectives.

Dr Godhe will explore statutory and contractual adjudication from both the UK and international perspectives, including:

- Key findings from the Construction Adjudication in the UK
- Tracing trends and guiding reform reports,
- Potential reforms to the Housing Grants, Construction and Regeneration Act 1996,
- Conflicts guidance
- Publication of decisions, and
- Diversity among adjudicators.

Dr Godhe will then explore why the British model of statutory adjudication has seen limited international uptake before examining the growing role of contractual adjudication through dispute boards, civil law ADR mechanisms and UNCITRAL initiatives. He will conclude with exploring future pathways for internationalisation, including model clauses, model laws and the possibility of an international convention on adjudication.
