18th October 2016 “BIM - new challenges, new disputes?”

Fiona Moore and Tim Willis

Fiona Moore will provide a hands on update on how BIM is being implemented in practice. Based upon Tim's talk given to Arbrix this year Tim will present the potential issues arising as BIM is introduced into the construction process. Together they will consider whether BIM will give rise to new challenges and new approaches to dispute resolution.

Fiona is a member of the UK Government's BIM Task Group, supporting Government Departments with their adoption of Building Information Management (BIM) in line with the current Government Construction Strategy. As Lead Architectural Designer/Technical Assessor on the UK Government's first BIM project at HMYOI Cookham Wood and then more widely across other Ministry of Justice projects, Fiona played a significant part in driving forward the adoption of BIM from 2011 onwards. With a background resulting in a wide breadth of construction industry knowledge and experience, through her own company, Cirrus Consultant Services, Fiona helps many organisations, including clients, consultants, constructors and suppliers, with their business development; involving, but not limited to, an understanding of the relevance of BIM to their organisation, helping to develop appropriate pragmatic strategies, planning implementation, training staff and managing change, in order to help drive real business benefits and value.
